"Júlia Vécsei's 2008 watercolor series, *Paperman* is also organized around the private symbolism of the motifs of nature and especially of the tree. The construction of the series can also be interpreted as a narrative in which plants and their roots are strongly emphasized elements. The latter dry out, turn out of the earth, sometimes entwine with one another or are reinterpreted as limbs of human figures.

The emphatic appearance of roots, plants and small animals in Júlia Vécsei's work express the organic, the elemental. They speak of the most closely interpreted communities functioning as atomic cores, and of the emotional range of human relations within them. In her images, female forms grow roots, sprout grass and serve as substrate. Yet the gray human figures have puzzling relationships to one another-they often appear in the same scene, but we get the sense that they are not bound together by strong ties.

The natural visions and dreamworlds that appear in the series' images often guide the viewer into the inscrutable subconscious of childhood, as in the case of the pigtailed girl with the double parachute. But based on this problematic, we can also talk about magic reflections, the apparent world of doubling, as in the case of the drinking fawn and its mirror reflection, or the trees that create the same gnarly structure both above and below the earth's surface.

Typical of the *Paperman* series is the color spectrum, reduced to two or three colors and based on gray watercolor, from which the other colors stand out strikingly. This gesture-like technique, requiring fast work and strong, firm lines adds to the enigmatic quality of the series. The tiny scenes, with their strong symbolism, and the entirety of their phenomena speak of the artists' affinities towards the metanarrative."



I have an independent publishing company called Klorofill, whose profile is publishing art zines (**rajz**lap / **drawing**-paper, Spot) and postcard sets (készlet / Set).

"Júlia Vécsei's other earlier works and projects also often used the format of the newspaper. In her projects *WW* and *HF*, she used the image of fashion and woodwork magazines to publish similar-looking newspapers – of course dedicated to art and to the context of the arts scene. Since 2007, the artist has published 12 limited edition fanzines called **drawing**paper; these have been dedicated entirely to the medium of drawing. The fanzines contain the drawings of an artist or those of a group working together, entirely without textual explanation, making it possible for the zines to transcend journalism and become reproduced art objects."
